Col. 4—Indicates the house-number in each family by the letter "H" followed by the number of the house in the block.
Col. 5—Indicates the family in the house by the letter "F" followed by the number of the family in the house.
Col. 6—Indicates the person in the family by the letter "P" followed by the number of the person in the family.
Col. 7—Indicates the sex of the person by the letter "M" for male and "F" for female.
Col. 8—Indicates the color of the person by the letter "W" for white, "N" for negro, "O" for other races, and "J" for Japanese.
Col. 9—Indicates the age of the person by the letter "A" followed by the age in years.
Col. 10—Indicates the marital condition of the person by the letter "M" for married, "S" for single, "D" for divorced, and "W" for widowed.
Col. 11—Indicates the education of the person by the letter "E" followed by the highest grade of school completed.
Col. 12—Indicates the place of birth of the person by the letter "B" followed by the name of the country or territory.
Col. 13—Indicates the mother tongue of the person by the letter "T" followed by the name of the language.
Col. 14—Indicates the language spoken in the home before coming to the United States by the letter "L" followed by the name of the language.
Col. 15—Indicates the year of immigration to the United States by the letter "Y" followed by the year.
Col. 16—Indicates the naturalization of the person by the letter "N" for naturalized, "C" for citizen, and "A" for alien.
Col. 17—Indicates the occupation of the person by the letter "O" followed by the name of the occupation.
Col. 18—Indicates the industry of the person by the letter "I" followed by the name of the industry.
Col. 19—Indicates the code of the person by the letter "C" followed by the code number.
Col. 20—Indicates the class of worker of the person by the letter "W" for wage earner, "P" for proprietor, and "S" for self-employed.
Col. 21—Indicates whether the person was actually at work yesterday by the letter "Y" for yes and "N" for no.
Col. 22—Indicates whether the person is a veteran of U. S. military or naval service by the letter "V" for yes and "N" for no.
Col. 23—Indicates the number of years since discharge of the veteran by the letter "Y" followed by the number of years.
