Item 21: SPECIAL CASES—Enter Yes also for persons who would have been looking for work except for— (a) own temporary illness (b) indefinite or more than 30-day layoff (c) belief that no work was available

Item 22: CODES FOR GRADE ATTENDED

Item 23a, 23b, and 23c: DEFINITION OF FAMILY HEAD

Item 24: What county and State was he living in a year ago?

Item 25: What country were his father and mother born in?

Item 26: What is the highest grade of school that he has attended?

Item 27: Did he finish this grade?

Item 28: Has he attended school at any time since February 1st?

Item 29: If looking for work (Yes in item 17)—How many weeks has he been looking for work?

Item 30: Last year, in how many weeks did this person do any work at all, not counting work around the house?

Item 31a, 31b, 31c: Income received by this person in 1949

Item 32a, 32b, 32c: Income received by his relatives in this household

Item 33a, 33b, 33c: Did he ever serve in the U. S. Armed Forces during—

Item 34: To enumerator: If worked last year (1 or more weeks in item 30): Is there any entry in items 29a, 29b, and 29c?

Item 35a: What kind of work did this person do in his last job?

Item 35b: What kind of business or industry did he work in?

Item 35c: Class of worker (P, G, O, or NP, as in item 20c)

Item 36: If ever married (Mar, Wid, D, or Sep in item 12)—Has this person been married more than once?

Item 37: If Mar—How many years since this person was (last) married? If Wid—How many years since this person was widowed? If D—How many years since this person was divorced? If Sep—How many years since this person was separated?

Item 38: If female and ever married (Mar, Wid, D, or Sep in item 12)—How many children has she ever borne, not counting stillbirths?
