SYMBOLS AND EXPLANATORY NOTES
 Col. 1. VALUE OF HOME IF OWNED: Where owner's household was placed only a part of a structure, estimate value of portion occupied by owner's household. Thus the value of the unit occupied by the owner of a two-family house might be approximately one-half the total value of the structure.
 Col. 2. COLOR OR RACE: White, Negro, Filipino, Indian, Chinese, Japanese, Other race, spell out in full.
 Col. 3. AGE AT LAST BIRTHDAY: Enter age of children born on or after April 1, 1939, as follows. Born in: April 1939, 11/4; May 1939, 10/12; June 1939, 9/12; July 1939, 8/12; August 1939, 7/12; September 1939, 6/12. (Do not include children born on or after April 1, 1940.)
 Col. 4. HIGHEST GRADE OF SCHOOL COMPLETED: None, Elementary school, last to 8th grade, 1, 2, etc., to 8; High school, last to 4th year, H-1, H-2, H-3, H-4; College, last to 4th year, C-1, C-2, C-3, C-4; College, 5th or subsequent year, C-5.
 Col. 5. CITIZENSHIP OF THE FOREIGN BORN: Naturalized, Pa; Having first papers, Pa; Alien, Al; American citizen born abroad, Am CH.
 Col. 6. WAS THIS PERSON AT WORK? Enter "Yes" for persons at work for pay or profit in private or non-profit enterprise, Government work, unpaid family workers, or in related non-work without money wages or salary on work (other than household or incidental chores) which contributed to the family income.
 Col. 7. DID THIS PERSON HAVE A JOB? Enter "Yes" for persons at work for pay or profit in private or non-profit enterprise, but did not work during week of March 26-30 for any of the following reasons: Temporary illness; industrial dispute; layoff not exceeding 6 weeks with instructions to return to work at a specific date; layoff due to temporary bad weather conditions.
 Col. 8 and 9. CLASS OF WORKER: Wage or salary worker in private work, PW; Wage or salary worker in Government work, GW; Employer, E; Working on own account, OA; Unpaid family worker, UF.
 Col. 10. WAR OR MILITARY SERVICE: World War, World War I, Philippine Insurrection, Spanish-American War, World War II, Regular establishment, Army, Navy, or Marine Corps, post-time service only, Other war or expedition.
